

Myths of Study Abroad

"It's financially impossible"

TRUTH:

- Exchange programs allow students to "swap" tuition, meaning you'd pay exactly the same as your UF tuition.
- Most Financial Aid students receive at UF (e.g. Bright Futures, Florida Prepaid, etc.) can be used for study abroad!
- UFIC and UF Departments offer hundreds of scholarships every year to UF students going abroad.
- UF is one of the Top Producers of Gilman Scholars a prestigious national grant that allows students of limited financial means to study or intern abroad.

"It will cause a late graduation"

TRUTH:

- Students can take courses abroad that count for their major, minor or gen ed requirements.
- Doing a program during the summer terms can actually help students get ahead in credits!
- Study abroad can be used to satisfy summer residency requirements.

"It's too complicated"

TRUTH:

- There are Study Abroad Advisors at UFIC who can help your students find the program that fits their personal, academic and professional goals.
- The staff and Study Abroad Peer Advisors (SAPAs) run weekly information sessions.
- Each semester UFIC holds a Study Abroad Fair where students can learn more about different programs, speak with Financial Aid, talk to an advisor and learn about scholarships.

"It's not safe"

TRUTH:

- Along with completing a risk assessment, we work to ensure all students are well informed about their overseas environment.
- Mandatory Pre-Departure Orientation covers best practices for students while abroad to ensure their safety and wellbeing.
- All students are enrolled in worldwide health insurance to cover any medical or safety emergencies.
- In the event of political unrest, a health emergency or natural disaster, UFIC is in close contact with on-site staff, local authorities, the US Department of State, insurance and the nearest US Embassy.
